The authors of the presentation are teachers from the Department of English language and literature from the Faculty of Education at the Comenius University. They co-operated with TRANSFER in the project LETS as authors of the module "Teaching at distance" and made the evaluations of materials for e-learning in language education.. Their work is aimed at the integration of modern information and communication technologies into the teaching of foreign languages and they deal with these problem area on the theoretical as well as practical levels. **PhDr. Jana Hromníková, PhD.**, deals within the framework of didactics of the English language with problems of CALL.. She introduced and since 1999 has been teaching the subjects "The use of computers in teaching of English language" and „Information and communication technologies in language education." She pursues this problem area also within the framework of further education of teachers where she deals with these problems through her publication activities, lectures and presentations at the professional seminars and conferences in Slovakia and abroad. Her dissertation (thesis) work was concentrated on the use of computers in the communicative approach to the teaching of English language. She participated actively in the work and tasks in the framework of international projects, e.g. Personal Online Paths – as a co-solver of the module for e-tutors "Pedagogical and didactic issues of e-learning". She was also a plenary speaker at the EUROCALL conference in 2004 in Vienna . **Mgr. Mária Kostelníková, PhD.**, acted as a coordinator and researcher of several international projects: Comenius Blau, Socrates Lingua – Exchange, Leonardo da Vinci – Personal Online Paths POP. At present she is a researcher and external evaluator in the project Leonardo da Vinci EuroPaths. Besides, she in her publication and lecturing activities deals with questions of multimedia, creation of hypertext, e-learning and mixed forms of teaching. **Doc. PhDr. Gabriela Lojová, PhD.**, - the head of the Department of English language and literature acts as an expert in the area of educational psychology and psycholinguistics. In her scientific and pedagogical activities she concentrates on questions of individual special characteristics of teaching and on teaching of grammar. She concentrates in her work on the elaboration of cognitive aspects of the processes of teaching languages which are activated in the creation of the system of the target language through e-learning, on the individual personality and affective factors which determine this process and condition its successfulness with the main stress on the elaboration of problems concerning the adequate strategies of teaching.
